SUBJECT: REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO SMOKING

As you may be aware there have been concerns voiced by some of the patrons of our facilities as they have to walk through cigarette smoke in order to either enter or leave a Community Centre or Arena.

Currently the City of Mississauga has posted signs at the entrances to all facilities asking that patrons not smoke within 8 metres of the front entrance to any facility. The ashtrays have also been moved at all of the facilities to comply with the 8 metre regulation.
